Wattage refers to the amount of electrical power a solar panel can produce under standard test conditions (STC), which simulate a bright sunny day with optimal solar irradiance (1,000 W/m<sup>2</sup>), a cell temperature of 25°C, and clean panels.

How do you calculate solar panel wattage?

Divide the average daily wattage usage by the average sunlight hours to measure solar panel wattage. Panel output efficiency, energy usage, sunshine exposure, system capacity, panel types, and materials all impact the calculation.
