What is a radio base station reconfiguration procedure?

This procedure outlines the application procedure to be followed by the mobile services operators (hereinafter called the "operators") for the reconfiguration of existing radio base stations NOT involving changes in the structural design and planning perspective of the parent building, and the change of land use.

How do I ensure a mobile base station installation is EME compliant?

Compliance relies on the successful design of a mobile base station installation. The location of neighbouring areas of interest must be reviewed to ensure EME compliance can be achieved with proposed construction drawings. Environmental Management Reports (EMR's) are required for all mobile base station installations.

How to shorten the processing time of a base station application?

To shorten the overall processing time of base station application, OFTA and Lands D have adopted parallel processing of applications in cases where a temporary waiver is required. The operator should submit applications to OFTA and Lands D (if a temporary waiver is required) in parallel.

Does a radio base station need planning permission?

A radio base station not meeting the definition of "Telecommunications Radio Base Station" is considered as a type of "Public Utility Installation". Whether it will require planning permission from the TPB will depend on the provisions of the concerned statutory plan.
