How does ECOWAS set the market procedures for the West African Power Pool?

ECOWAS also sets the market procedures for the West African Power Pool. To begin the procedure, any entity which owns or operates transmission infrastructure must apply for admission to the market itself. Entities holding power purchase agreements of bilateral agreements may also apply for admission and acceptance as a Market Participant.
